

Internet access: Free Wi-Fi is provided throughout the conference venue and Moonraker Point Residence.

Currency, bank cards: The official currency is Pound Sterling. There are ATMs near the Strand campus and card readers are wide-spread in shops, restaurants, pubs and bars nearby.

Electricity: Electricity is supplied at 230V, 50Hz, but adapters will be needed for attendees from abroad since plugs and sockets in the United Kingdom adhere to type G (three pin plug).

Insurance: The Organising Committee for 9th UK Nuclear Envelope and Chromatin Organization Meeting and 3rd International Meeting on Laminopathies do not assume responsibility for injuries of persons or losses of personal belongings during the conference. Participants are therefore advised to ensure proper travel and health insurance policies are in place.

Visas: With the United Kingdom leaving the European Union in spring 2019, it is currently unclear whether visa will be required by attendees from abroad. Please check with your own authorities before travel.

Weather: Early September is warm in London and about 20/13°C. Rain can fall year-round.
